Wealth inequality affects us all. The League of Women Voters of Wisconsin recently adopted a position on economic inequality based on the lengthy study completed by the LWV of Ashland/Bayfield. The following events on this topic planned by Focus on Fairness, a local organization, may be of interest to members:

- Tuesday, October 16 at 7 PM at the Kress Pavilion, Egg Harbor: "Opening the Door on Economic inequality." The reality and social implications of wealth disparity will be discussed by Dr. Dylan Fitz, Assistant Professor of Economics at Lawrence University.
- Wednesday, October 24 at 7 PM at the Kress Pavilion, Egg Harbor: "Born on Third Base." Chuck Collins, Senior Scholar at the Institute for Policy Studies, Washington, D.C., is a one-percenter making the case for tackling inequality, bringing wealth home, and committing to the common good.
- Saturday, October 27 at 7 PM at the Kress Pavilion, Egg Harbor: Candidate Forum. Candidates for local and state office will discuss fairness, wealth inequality, and increasing economic opportunity for Door County.
